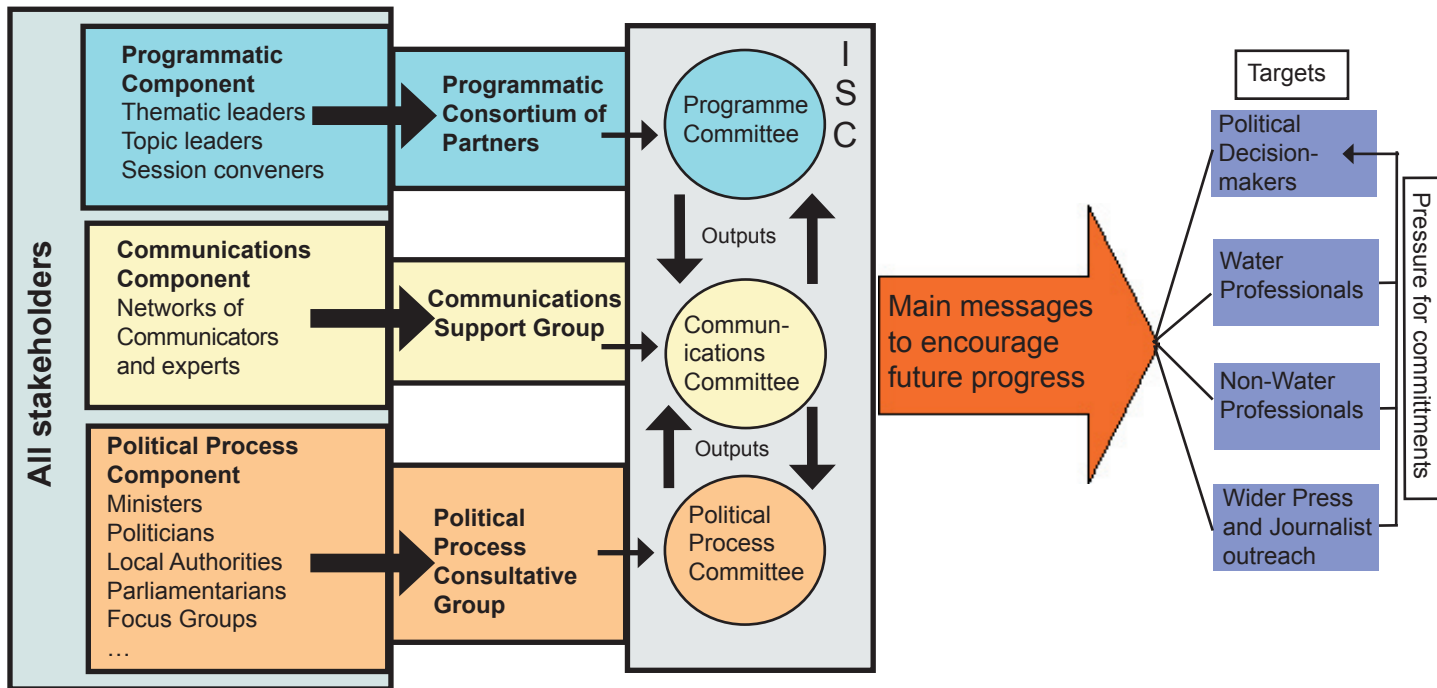
■ Towards the 5th World Water Forum

The 5th World Water Forum, co-organized by the Turkish Government and the World Water Council, will take place in **Istanbul, Turkey, 16-22 March 2009**. Three separate Committees have been established under the authority of the International Steering Committee (ISC) to lead the organisation of Programme, Political Process and Communications components. Each is composed by an equal number of Turkish representatives and World Water Council members.



■ Programme Development

Through a pyramidal conception, the programme for the 5th Forum will provide focus on the overarching theme of "Bridging Divides for Water". A consortium of institutions will be involved in the development of each theme led by a thematic coordinator in accordance with guidelines prepared by the Programme Committee. Approximately three sessions will be identified for each topic to allow for an open interaction and dialogue which will enable the bridging of divides between actors and sectors, between different regions and levels of economic development, between men and women and between the present and the future.
